







Wonderoom:








- 2. Mr. Pratul Vasistha gave three online sessions on the topics-

He also handles a Facebook group named Online Research Workshop-2020, in which he engages with children through various activities.








- 3. Mr. Rajneesh Bisht has also been engaged in English speech sessions and Wonderoom platform group on Whatsapp.

Mr. Ashwani A. Masih started a Green Club with the help of children in his society. They planted around 50 plants to keep the society green.













Rajiv Sadbhavana Media Lab (RSML):


Sadbhavana application for android-




