
















Sadbhavana Se Samadhan Run across Delhi-NCR:







Wonderoom:

He also handles a Facebook group named Online Research Workshop-2020, in which he engages with children through various activities.








- 3. Mr. Rajneesh Bisht has also been engaged in English speech sessions and Wonderoom platform group on Whatsapp.


Socio-technical Knowledge, Innovation & Learning Lab (SKILLAB):















Rajiv Sadbhavana Media Lab (RSML):




3. Bringing together various experts from Rajiv Gandhi Foundation, and creating educational, entertaining, and accessible programs for children, we continued our WonderZoom sessions


this month. These sessions included workshops, talks, presentations, as well as sessions by various guest speakers from different fields.
