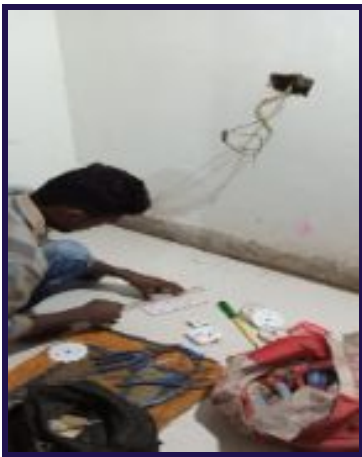

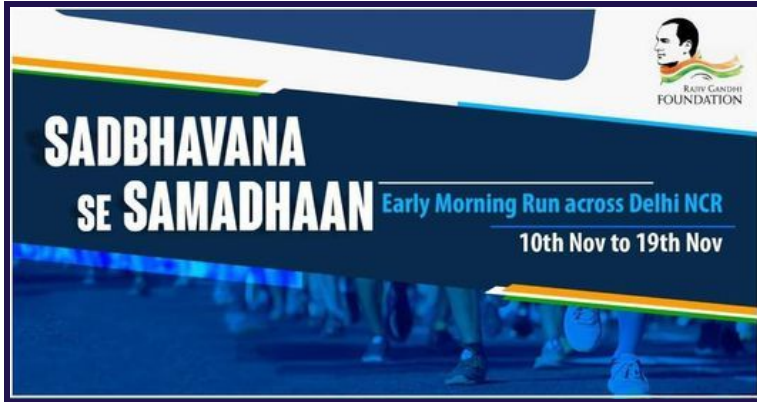




## Sadbhavana Se Samadhan Run across Delhi-NCR:

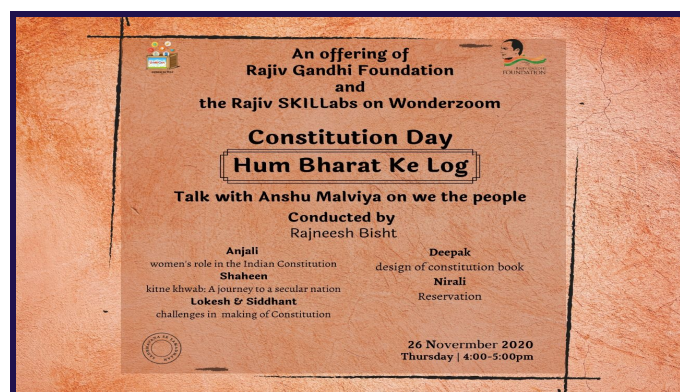
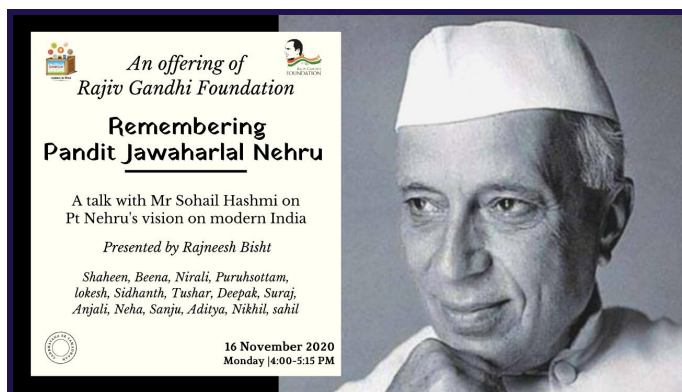




## Wonderoom:

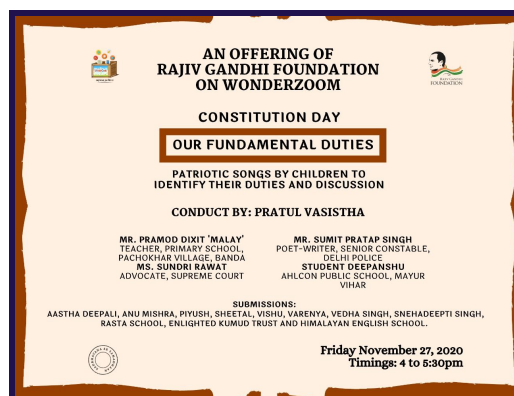
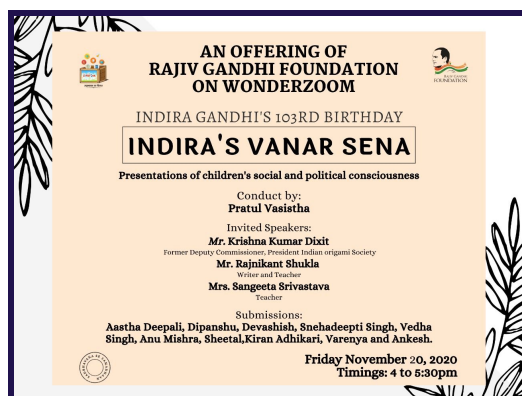

  - 2.) Constitution "Our Fundamental Duties"

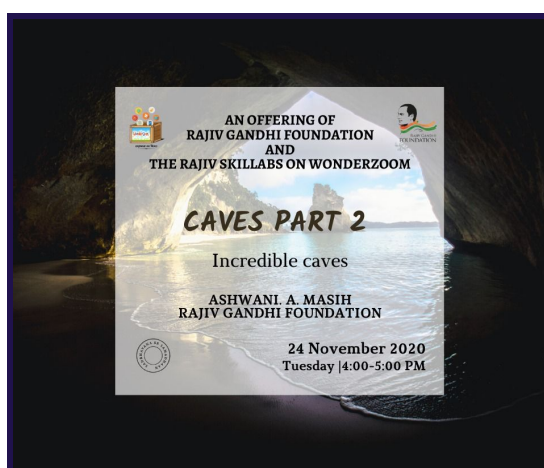
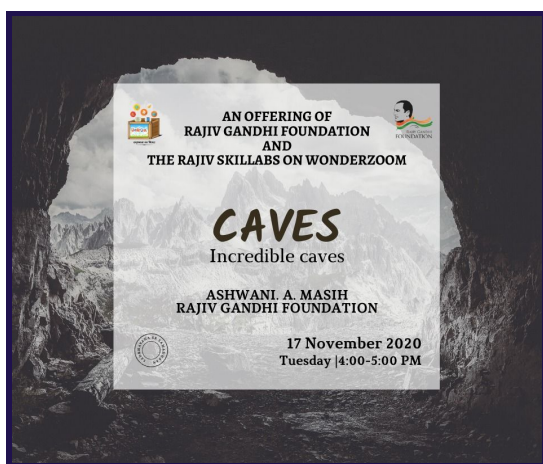
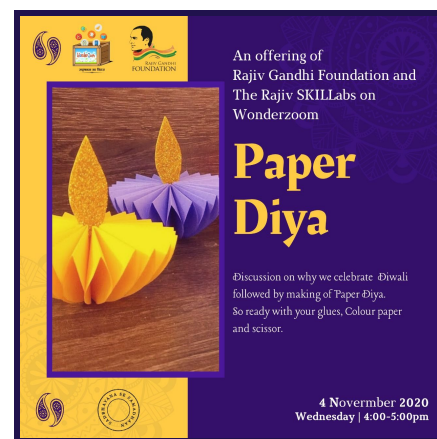
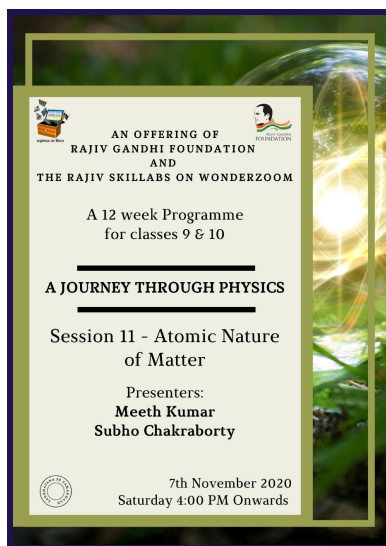
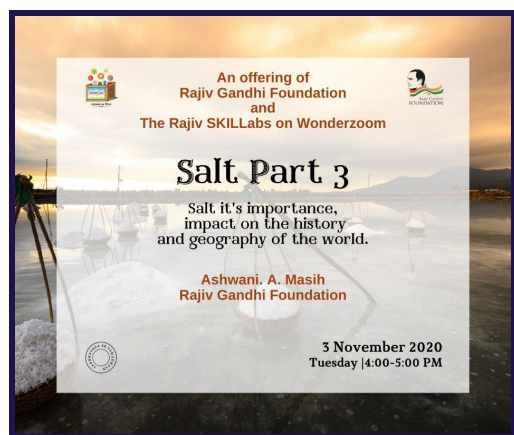
He also handles a Facebook group named Online Research Workshop-2020, in which he engages with children through various activities.

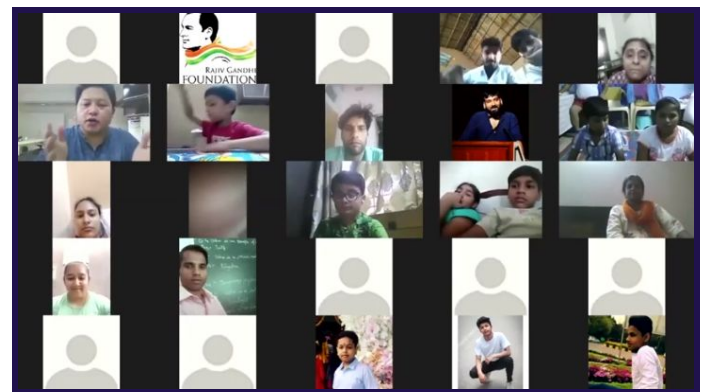
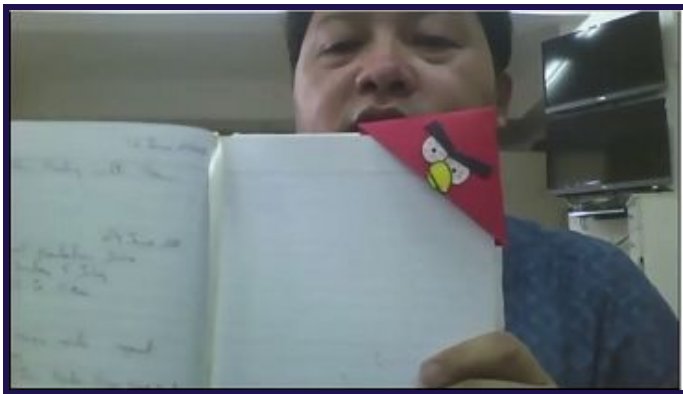




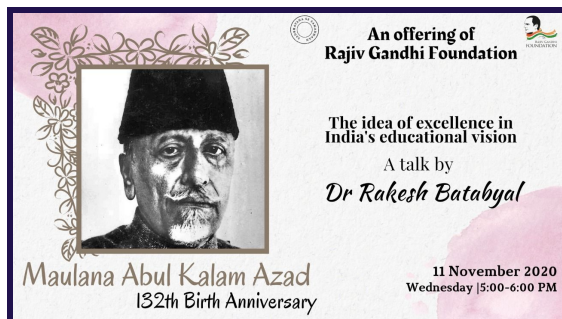
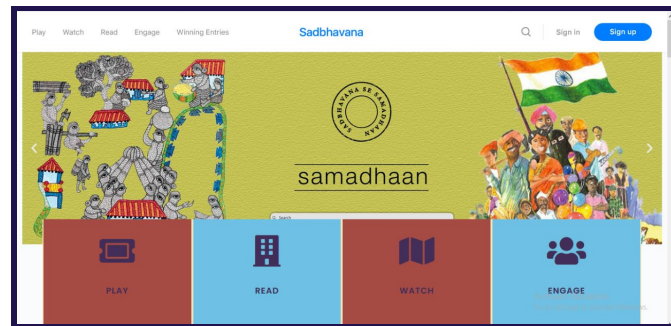
RSML has been working on engaging social media viewers by creating videos and posters for RGF, RGICS and for Sadbhavana Web portal.

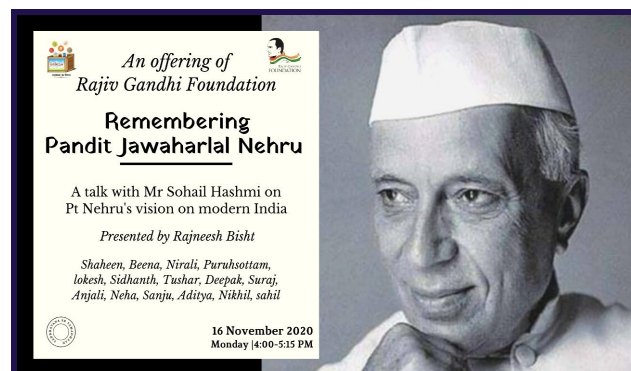
5. Two consecutive programs were organized on the occasion of Constitution Day (26 November)



6. A special program was organized for Smt. Indira Gandhi's 103rd birth anniversary.



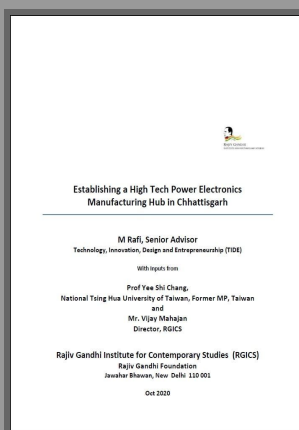
