

Sufia met with the Governor of Rajasthan, Shri Kalraj Mishra ji at Rajbhawan Jaipur.
















Wonderoom:


Mr. Rajneesh Bisht has also been engaged in English speech sessions and Wonderoom platform group on Whatsapp.

Mr. Pratul Vasistha gave three online sessions on Katha Utsav.









Mr. Pratul Vasistha also handles a Facebook group named Online Research Workshop-2020, in which he engages with children through various activities.

- 4. These sessions included workshops, talks, presentations, as well as sessions by various guest speakers from different fields.


- 5. Sadbhavana Abhiyan : The golden quadrilateral run by Sufiya can be followed on our website.
- 6. Sadbhavana Friends program is starting very soon, giving children an opportunity to spread the message of Sadbhavana with us.




