Sufia made a record of 'First and Fastest Female' to cover India Gate to Gateway of India by running in 29 Days 01 Hours and 11 minutes.

The Police Department and Sports Association of Hubli-Dharwad also joined her.

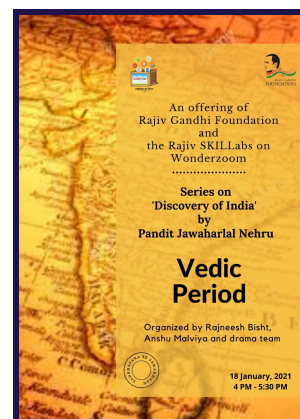
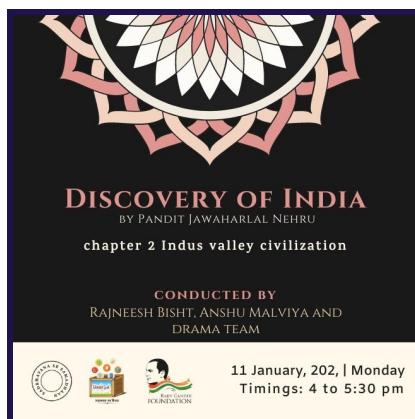
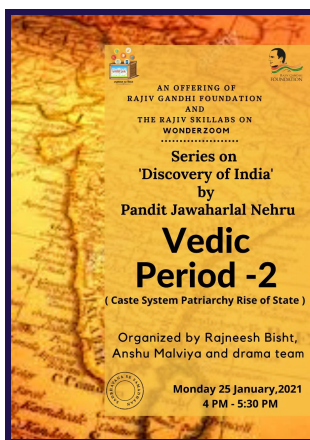


Wonderoom:

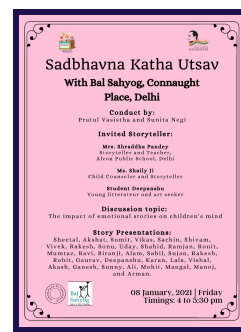
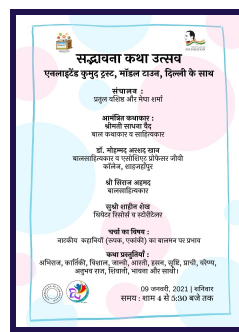
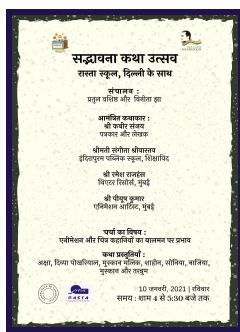
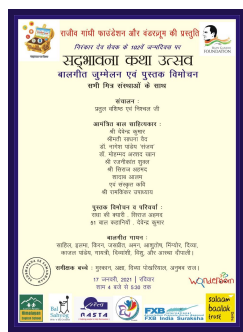
The Wonderoom team has been actively participating in the Wonderzoom sessions. The Wonderoom team has got more sessions scheduled for next month as well.

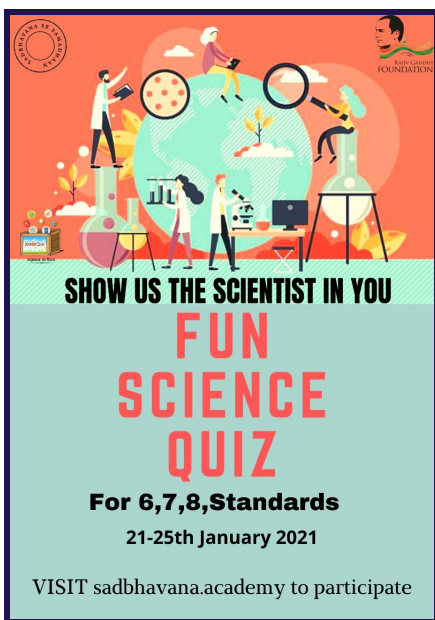
RSML has been working on engaging social media viewers by creating videos and posters for RGF, RGICS and for Sadbhavana Web portal.

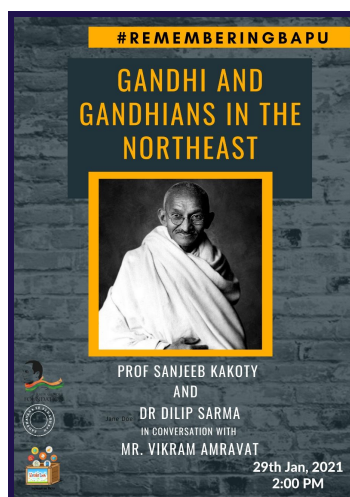

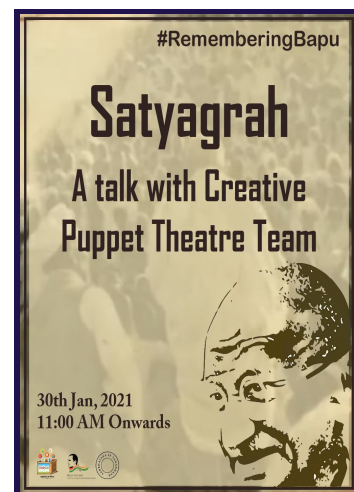

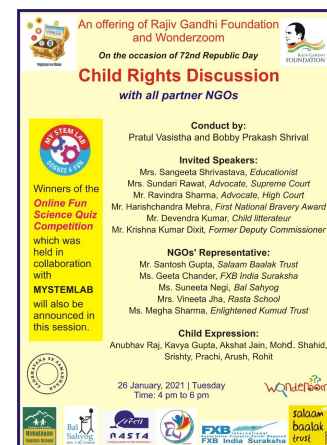
3.) Sadbhavana Abhiyan : The golden quadrilateral run by Sufiya can be followed on our website.
